Would you be keen to help Natura Pacific equip Queenslanders to do more for nature?

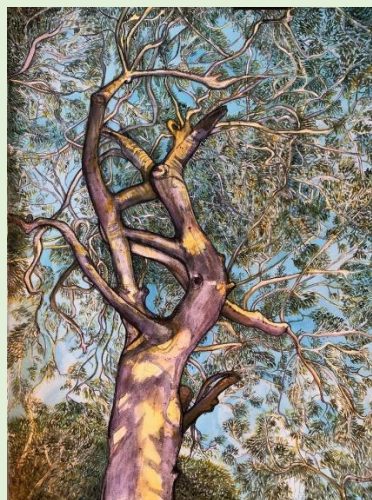
